Information on the Heavy Traffic Class 5 Course

The Class 5 Licence can be a 1 day course if you have evidence of good logbook skills and done Unit 24089. Otherwise its a 2 day

Course.

The 1st day you will be instructed on the Class 5 & General Road Code for a couple of hours and when you are ready you then head down to the A/A or VTNZ to sit the Class 5 Learner Licence. (You are not required to purchase a road code for this.) You will come back and will be trained and work through a work book on your Class 5 Licence (This is an open book as it is part of your learning process) and then you will sit the assessment test. (Closed Book)

If you are only doing 1 day, you will then be taken for a pre assessment drive which can take from 15mins to 1 hour depending on your experience. After that, the assessor will take you for a practical drive. Once you have been found competent on the Assessment and Drive you will be given a Class 5 Licence Certificate to take to the A/A or VTNZ. If you have to do the Logbook Unit Standard there will be a 2nd day, you will be put through the work book and then there will be an assessment test.

Note:

If you have evidence of good logbook skills and done Unit Standard 24089 you only need to do the 1 day course which includes; a training on the licence, pre assessment drive and assessment. Otherwise its a 2 day course.
